New Equipment Installed

Shire of Dalwallinu 24 Hour Gym

The Shire of Dalwallinu have recently upgraded some of the equipment in the gymnasium. Only one new elliptical machine has been installed with an extra treadmill replacing the second elliptical. The treadmills are constantly in use and the ellipticals were not used as much. The bike and rowing machines were also replaced. The new screens are similar to the old but with a few small differences. Instructions sheets are in place to assist members with their initial use.



We welcome the younger members of our community to the gym (12-18 years old) but remind you that they must be accompanied by a paid adult member at all times whilst in the gymnasium. Failure to adhere to the rules in place could jeapordise your membership.

An in-person information session for prospective Elected Members will be held on Tuesday 29 August 2023 at 6pm at the Council Chambers. Nominations will open on 31 August 2023 and close 4pm, Thursday 7 August 2023.

This election will also see optional preferential voting rather than first past the post as in previous LG elections.


LG Election – Saturday 21 October 2023

The proposed road closure is highlighted in red in the above map and is from the northern end of the hockey oval to the Goodlands Rd intersection.


